



ERD II – Enables the student to develop detailed knowledge and advanced skills in Emergency Response Diving. Serves as a base to develop experience and meet the prerequisites for enrollment in the ERD II Ops Components and ERD Supervisor.

Prerequisites – Must be at least 18 years of age. Must have an ERD I certification (or equivalent). Must have CPR1st and CPROX training (or equivalent). Must have 10 or more logged public safety dives (either training or operational dives beyond ERD I with a recognized public safety dive team).

Equipment Required:

- 1) Equipment as required for ERD I diver.
- 2) Drysuit with appropriate insulation suitable for emergency response diving.
- 3) Full face mask with communications capabilities.

Duration of course – Three days.

Classroom and briefing: Approximately 8 hours

Confined Water work: Approximately 4 hours

Open Water Dives: Minimum 6 dives required.

Cost of course -- \$450 per person includes manual and certification card (if successful).
\$400 per person for groups of 10 or more.
